Ongoing Formation Hours Due

As 2007 comes to an end, please remember to complete your annual Ongoing Formation Hours form and send in to this office by December 31.

As a reminder, active deacons are required to submit 25 ongoing formation hours annually. Please refer to pp. 70 of your Deacon Handbook for the categories and distribution of hours as they apply to your hours. You can view a sample form on pp. 109.

If you are in need of an Ongoing Formation Form, you may enlarge pp. 110 of your Deacon Handbook or access the form from the deacon website in the members only section at www.opdrfd.org. The username is `rfddeacon` and the password is `scripture`, all lowercase letters.

Preaching Certification

Deacons who are in need of Preaching Certification to preach on Sundays and other Holy Days must contact the office no later than January 31, 2008. Certification is granted after successful completion of an appropriate class and successfully delivering a prepared homily before the Most Reverend Thomas Doran.

Those who have contacted the office will be notified after January 31 and assigned a topic for preaching, and given a date to preach before Bishop Doran as well as additional information.

Certification is available for deacons who have attended and fulfilled the required preaching classes or have come from outside the diocese and have not yet completed the certification process.

Pre-nuptial and Annulment Certification opportunity

Deacons wishing to become certified for Pre-nuptial and Annulment preparation are invited to attend the class with the Candidates in formation.

The class will be held Saturday, April 19, 2008 at the Newman Center, DeKalb, 9:00 AM - 2:30 PM. Attending the class also qualifies for 4.5 hours of ongoing formation credit.

The test, required to take and pass for certification, is scheduled for Saturday, May 3, 2008 at the Cathedral of St. Peter at 9:00 AM.

To attend this class you must contact the office to register. The next opportunity for this class will likely not be for two years or more.

Of Interest: Permanent Deacons requiring Preaching Recertification for 2007 have a final opportunity for recertification before expiration notification is sent to pastors. The Homiletics III class for those in formation is available for recertification. Class dates are: Saturday, Feb. 9, 16, March 8 & 29, 9:00 AM - noon at St. Mary, Durand. As a reminder, you must attend all classes for recertification. Participation of this class also receives 12 hours of ongoing formation credit. Please contact the office if you wish to attend.

Annual Deacon Assembly Day: Please reserve Saturday, February 23, 2008 on your calendar to attend the annual Deacon Assembly Day. You will receive registration and schedule information for that day in January. Candidacy I, Class of 2010, will be admitted into Candidacy during Mass at Assembly Day.

Ongoing Formation Opportunities: The following classes have been made available for Ongoing Formation Credit:

Ecumenism: Tuesday, January 8, 15, 22, 29, and Feb. 5 6:00 - 8:30 PM at Newman Center, DeKalb. Qualifies for 12.5 hours of ongoing formation credit.

Deacon as Teacher: January 19, 2008, 9:00 AM - 2:30 PM. at the Cathedral of St. Peter. Qualifies for 4.5 hours of ongoing formation credit.

Advanced Morality: Tuesday, March 4, 11, 18, 25, and April 1, 6:30 - 9:00 PM at the Diocesan Administration Building. Qualifies for 12.5 hours of ongoing formation credit.
