Annual Deacon Assembly Day

Attending this year were 111 deacons, 8 candidates and 58 wives, making this year the largest attended Assembly Day.



The day began with Mass celebrated by Bishop Thomas G. Doran. Following Bishop Doran's address to those attending, Monsignor William Schwartz began the day recognizing those deacons in attendance celebrating

milestone anniversaries as permanent deacons, introducing our two newest deacons to the diocese, Deacons John Nelson and Mark Chaplin, and the Candidates,

Class of 2008, who are to be ordained May 24, 2008.

Monsignor made the following announcements: The Symposium for Priests and Deacons of the Diocese of Rockford will be Friday, September 12, 2008 at Giovanni's Restaurant and Convention Center. Christopher West will present "Created and Redeemed," a seminar based on Pope John Paul II's Theology of the Body.

Two Ongoing Formation programs were announced. Pontifical College Josephinum is providing a distance learning program on line for the diaconate. Those interested are to contact the office to facilitate registration. The Diocese of Rockford Diocesan Theological Institute was introduced. The institute is an ongoing formation opportunity for the graduates of Ministry Formation as well as for the Permanent Diaconate. Classes will be offered on Saturday's and possibly week nights from Fall to Spring. Course offerings for 2008/2009: World Religions, Jesus of Nazareth, Spiritual Direction, The Gospels, Theological Reflection, Fathers of the Church, Church Teaching on Life Issues, Church History, Lead Like Jesus, Vatican II Documents, Meeting Christ in the Liturgy. Unique to this Assembly Day were table assignments. Because we are a "community of strangers," deacons, candidates and their wives were separated and assigned to tables away from classmates and parishes. Monsignor Schwartz used this opportunity, when most deacons of the diocese were present, to learn what is needed. He began with asking "What are the gifts that are evident in the diaconate of the Diocese of Rockford"? After discussing as a table, each table answered aloud with: "self denial, service to parish, diversity, empowerment, spirituality," just to name a few. Each person was then asked to write responses to the question "What are the challenges facing our diaconate today?"



Each person wrote down challenges. After more table discussion, each table wrote their top three responses on a large easel sheet, taping them to the wall for viewing. Some of the challenges presented were: Education, parish / pastor support, spiritual support, wife participation / programs just to name a few.

Following lunch, the new diocesan directories were distributed by Elvira Duffey, Carol Fast and Linda Cooper. If you were unable to attend, you will receive your new directory via regular mail. After discussing the challenges, they were then asked to "Keep It Real" and offer ideas and suggestions.

After more table discussion, a designated person wrote down their ideas and suggestions. A spokesperson for each table presented their ideas. Some ideas and suggestions offered were: Mentoring for Deacon wives, Deanery Meetings using an agenda / specific purpose, establish a Diaconate Diocesan Board to serve as a consultative group to Monsignor Schwartz.

After reviewing all the materials, deacons and wives will each receive a questionnaire in the near future. You will be asked to complete the questionnaire and return to the office. The information will be used to go forward in the next step.



Keeping you informed ...Ordination: May 24, 2008

The Class of 2008 will be ordained Permanent Deacons May 24, 2008 along with the Seminarian ordinandi. Attending ordination is by ticket only. Due to space constraints, the Class of 2008 were each allotted only 14 general and 11 family seating tickets. Limited space also allows for only 22 permanent deacons to vest. The candidates provided us with names of deacons from their parishes as well as relationships formed during their five years of formation. Thank you for your understanding.

Ongoing Formation Hours Form

Enclosed is a revised Ongoing Formation Hours Form for your use. Active deacons are required to attend one retreat annually. Ongoing Formation Hours do not apply for attending one retreat. Should you opt to attend a second retreat within the same year, you may add the hours of one retreat to your ongoing formation hours. All active deacons of this diocese are required to complete 25 clock hours annually.

Pre-Nuptial / Annulment Class

Deacons wishing to assist in preparation of Pre-nuptial / Annulment paperwork must receive certification. Deadline for registration for this class is April 4, 2008.

The class will be held Saturday, April 19, 2008 at Newman Center, DeKalb 9:00 AM - 2:30 PM. The test, required to take and pass, is scheduled for Saturday, April 26, 2008 at the Diocesan Admin. Bldg. at 9:00 AM.
